We will continue on the ground, with our horses online. A variety of stimuli in the form of scary objects and scenarios will be presented to the



horses. From the safety of being on the ground learn how to introduce your horse to these objects and how to build their confidence.

After Lunch - Get Ready to Ride! We will encounter additional scary obstacles from the saddle. And learn the basic Natural Horsemanship skills needed if your horse spooks when you are in the saddle. In an Introduction to Rider Biomechanics, Kelly will show you how important it is to ride correctly so you stay in the saddle if your horse does spook!

This will prepare you for what to do, how to do it, and how to stay safe and survive if your horse does indeed spook.
